

Verge Management







- □ A Fermanagh-wide agreement with Roads Service. The erection of verge signs prevents grass cutting till mid-August on up to 20 wildlife rich sites
- ☐ In 2016, the signs were up from May 18th to August 18th a period of exactly 3 months.
- □Summer 2017 will provide an opportunity to undertake Rapid Assessment surveys to assess the full extent of species richness recovery






