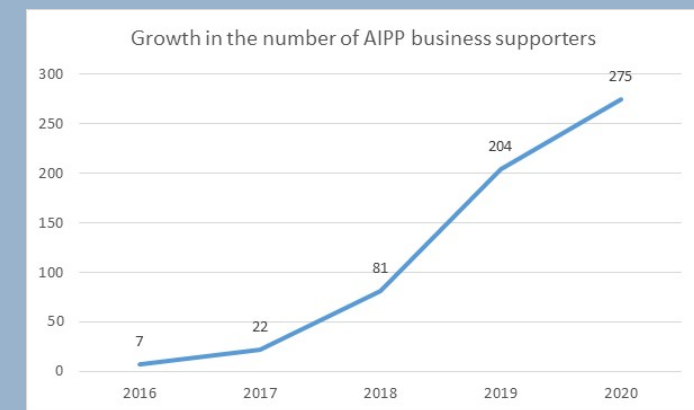
24 Councils across the island (55%) have formally partnered with the Plan and agreed to take actions



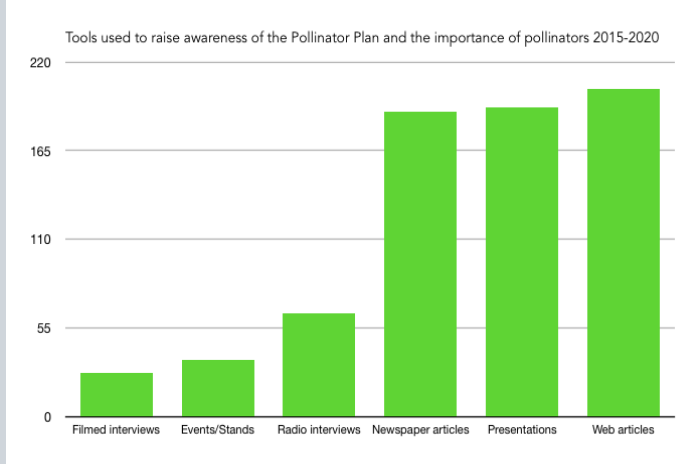
Increasing numbers of people have accessed identification resources and submitted records



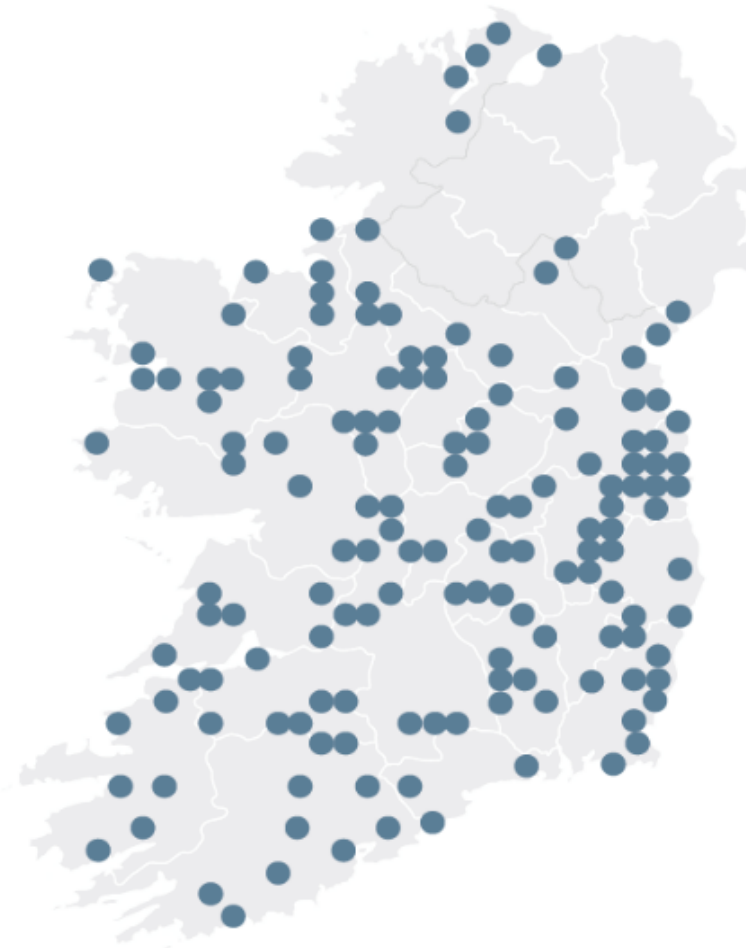

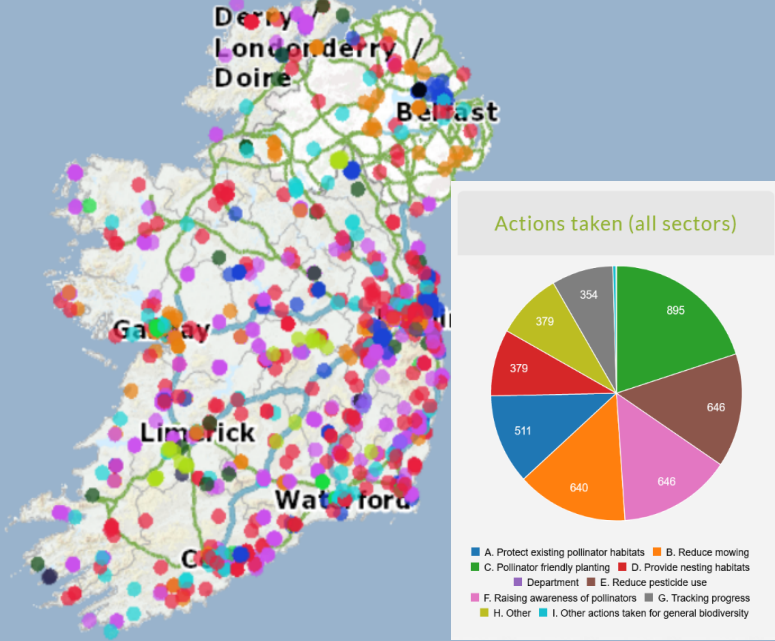
Awareness raising has continued throughout the life of the Plan



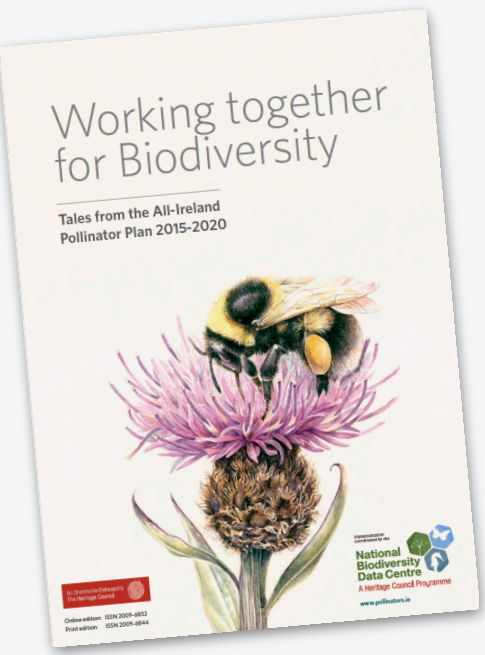
Over 160 pollinator-friendly towns and villages, from every county, have entered the Local Authority Pollinator Award
