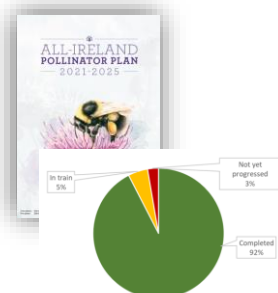

### 100% of Councils have become partners



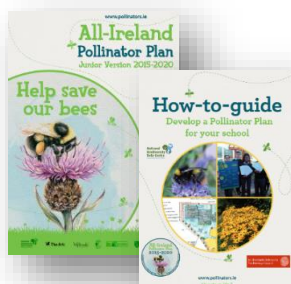
### Created an evidence-based pollinator-score for farms



### 200+ local communities are pollinator friendly



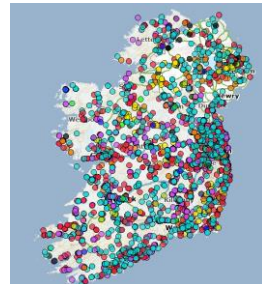
### Schools have become pollinator friendly

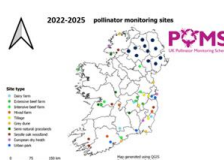
### Public support for pollinator conservation
